UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON CONTRACTS FOR THE

VIENNA, 11 APRIL 1980

PROPOSAL OF CORRECTIONS TO THE ORIGINAL OF THE CONVENTION  
(ARABIC AUTHENTIC TEXT) AND TO THE CERTIFIED TRUE COPIES

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The attention of the Secretary-General has been drawn to the fact that it appears that paragraph 2 of article 76 has been omitted in the Arabic authentic text of the original of the Convention as reproduced in the certified true copies established on 12 May 1980, circulated by depositary notification C.N.196.1980.TREATIES-2 of 22 July 1980, and in the certified true copies established on 6 July 1988 and corrected by procès-verbaux of 19 February 1999 and 27 April 2000.<sup>1</sup>

..... The Annex to this notification contains the proposed text of paragraph 2 of article 76.

In accordance with the established depositary practice, unless there is an objection from a signatory State or a contracting State, the Secretary-General proposes to insert, in the Arabic authentic text of the original of the Convention, the above paragraph 2 to article 76. Such correction would also apply to the certified true copies.

Any objection should be communicated to the Secretary-General within 90 days of the present notification, i.e. no later than Friday, 24 November 2000.
